



Water users & coming ashore Code of Conduct



Before arriving on Lundy, make sure you are familiar with the following points to protect the island's habitats and wildlife. Please report any acts of misconduct to the warden (warden@lundyisland.co.uk)



Keep your boat speed below 5 knots.



Lundy is rat-free. Please check your vessel and cargo as they can harbour rodents. Take all rubbish home, especially perishables.



Never pick or damage animals, plants or fungi.



Please keep a respectful distance from all wildlife and feral stock. In particular, maintain at least 100m distance from hauled out seals and seabird colonies.



Abide by the climbing and scrambling restrictions (please visit the Lundy website for up-to-date information).



The use of drones is strictly prohibited across the island and anywhere within the MPA.



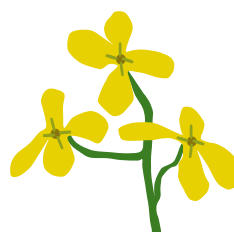
Use a zoom lens when taking photographing seals, seabirds or other sensitive wildlife and avoid the use of flash photography.



Never directly approach seals or attempt to follow them on land or in the water. Let them come to you on their own terms if they choose to.



If you observe behaviour that may indicate stress, such as increased vocalisation, teeth bearing or rapid entry to the water, please move away.
